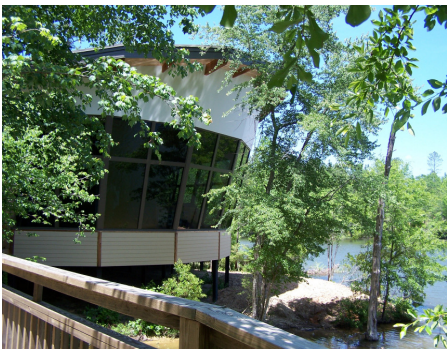


Environmental Center

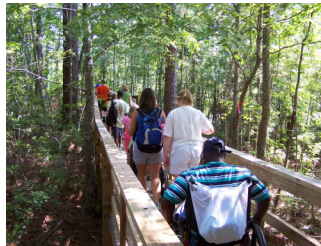


How Can You Help?
