

INFORMATION SHEET FOR ASCCA SUMMER CAMPS

- Mailing Address:** Camp ASCCA. P. O. Box 21, Jackson's Gap, AL 36861.
- Location:** Physical address: 5278 Camp ASCCA Dr. Jackson's Gap AL 36861
- Arrival:** **Check in will be between 2:00 and 4:30 pm on Sunday.** *Check-in and Check-out times will be different for session #5. You will receive a separate email closer to summer*
- THE PERSON BRINGING THE CAMPER TO CAMP MUST STAY WITH THE CAMPER UNTIL HIS/HER CHECK-IN IS COMPLETE.**
- Departure:** **Departure will be on Friday at 9:15 a.m. CST.** There will be a \$50 per ½ hour charge for pick-ups after 10:30 a.m. You must have your ID ready and sign out with nursing staff.
- Spending Money:** **There is no need for spending money at camp.** T-shirts may be purchased on check-in and check-out days.
- Visiting:** Parents, relatives, and friends of the campers are welcome to visit and tour the facility on arrival, and departure days.
- Correspondence:** We hope that you plan to write your camper frequently. A letter or card from home is always a welcome sight. Cell phones are not permitted at camp. You can also email the Camp Director – matt@campascca.org
- Food:** The campers and staff of Camp ASCCA will be served three (3) nutritious, well-planned meals daily, plus an afternoon snack. Please do not send extra food. (Exceptions will be made for some special diets.)
- Phone:** The camp phone (256) 825-9226. You may leave a message with Camp Director or office. Campers will not have access to phones. **Cell Phones are not allowed at camp during the summer.**
- Parent Notification:** Every effort will be made by telephone to notify parent or guardian of a serious illness, injury, accident, or behavior problem; hence the importance of providing the camp staff with phone numbers of your whereabouts during the camp session or a responsible party in your absence.
- Staff:** Staff members will be with the campers at all times. Counselors sleep in the cabins with the campers. A Nurse is on 24-hour duty, and emergency care has been established with Russell Medical Center in Alexander City and Lake Martin Community Hospital in

Dadeville.

Please write names or at least initials on all clothing tags.

Take a moment on check-out day to insure that all personal items are returned to camper. Camp ASCCA is **NOT** responsible for lost items. Please remember to label clothes w/ camper's name or at least initials.

* Send any special equipment, braces, wheelchairs, communication boards, devices that may be used for behavior modification & other appliances or aids used by camper. Be sure to bring the charges for these devices!

***You will need to provide your own wheelchair/adaptive devices, for campers that are ambulatory but cannot walk long distance.**

* All campers requiring assistance in toileting should furnish non-latex gloves and "flushable" baby wipes for cabin counselors use.

Medications:
