Here is a look at two ways Camp ASCCA helps bring environmental education and amazing, unique experiences to campers of all abilities!



Drake Middle School from Auburn, AL recently visited Camp ASCCA for a series of Day Camps for their 6th grade students. Drake has been visiting camp for several years now participating in Environmental and Outdoor Education Camps. This year they enjoyed activities like our Zip Line, Group Elements, Water Slide, Canoeing, GPS, and Environmental Center Nature Jeopardy. As shown in the picture to the right, GPS teaches important navigational skills and introduces new technology in a fun and entertaining way. The kids had a great time at Camp ASCCA. We loved providing them with activities that would broaden their minds and encourage them to understand nature and their fellow students a little better.

The Middle Tallapoosa River Basin Clean Water Partnership presented Camp ASCCA with a \$1,365 donation. The funds will go toward the Campership Fund, which provides financial assistance to campers who cannot afford the full cost of attending a camp session. The Partnership raised the money by auctioning off 12 rain barrels Camp ASCCA campers painted at a workshop in July.
