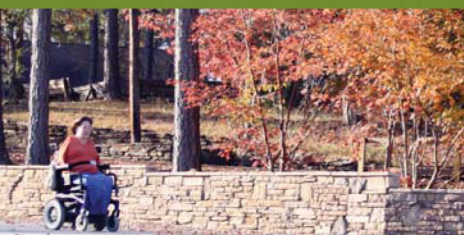

We are proud to announce the Alabama District Pilots International have taken this project on for their charitable giving to Camp ASCCA in 2011!

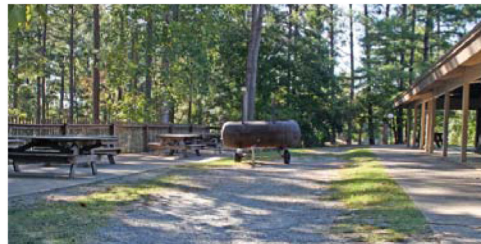
There's always ROOM TO IMPROVE..

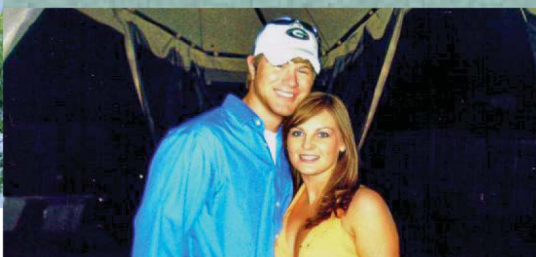

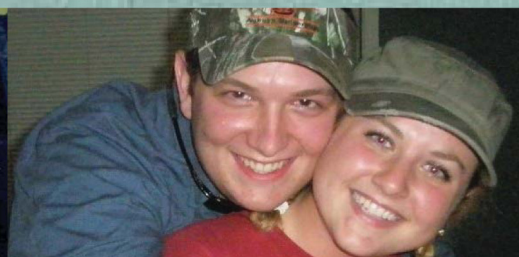

Here is a look at two ways Camp ASCCA helps bring environmental education and amazing, unique experiences to campers of all abilities!



Drake Middle School from Auburn, AL recently visited Camp ASCCA for a series of Day Camps for their 6th grade students. Drake has been visiting camp for several years now participating in Environmental and Outdoor Education Camps. This year they enjoyed activities like our Zip Line, Group Elements, Water Slide, Canoeing, GPS, and Environmental Center Nature Jeopardy. As shown in the picture to the right, GPS teaches important navigational skills and introduces new technology in a fun and entertaining way. The kids had a great time at Camp ASCCA.
