## The Meredith Birchfield Foundation sponsors 2014 equestrian program

Annually, Camp ASCCA serves an average of 1,300 individuals with intellectual and/or physical disabilities. Most of these individuals participate in our summer camp program. During their stay, each camper has the opportunity to participate in our horseback riding program!

The riding program is tailored to the individual's cognitive and physical abilities. The outcome of the program is geared to give the camper another opportunity for personal growth – both through confidence and life experience. We feel that this program is part of the core of activities offered during Camp ASCCA's 38 year history.

Finding and hiring qualified staff, care for the horses, barn/pasture maintenance, saddles, and safety equipment quickly add up annually. Meredith Birchfield, through her foundation, has generously sponsored Camp ASCCA's equestrian program for the year with a gift of \$22,000.

Studies have shown that equestrian programs – including those programs targeting individuals with disabilities – greatly benefit the participant in many areas. The benefits range from sensory stimulation to skill acquisition. Camp ASCCA prides itself on being able to meet the needs of each individual participating in the program.

## A trip to Beijing... *Sharing of knowledge*

Last summer we hosted guests from Beijing who were finding out more about our programs here at Camp ASCCA in order to, in the near future, construct a similar program for people with disabilities in China.

Late this April, our friends in China hosted two of our staff members, John Stephenson and Matt Rickman, a Camp ASCCA board member, Dr. Glenn Roswal, and Dr. Aija Klavina from Latvia, who is a professor specializing in therapeutic recreation. Dr. Roswal, who is an expert in therapeutic recreation and Special Olympics worldwide, has for years visited and worked with Dr. Lu "Lucy" Yan and her students at Beijing Sport University. Dr. Lucy's son, Han "Hans" Xiao, and one of her graduate students, Eric, toured with the group as well.



The group spoke to several of Dr. Lucy's university classes, toured the region, and met with parents of children with disabilities. Four or five families are going to come spend two weeks at Camp ASCCA this August. Parents and counselors for the children with special needs will make the trip to have an amazing time at Camp ASCCA!

Additionally, the group hopped onto an airplane and traveled to Huangshan City, and a village near there – Xidi, to tour a proposed site for their own camp program for people with disabilities.

We hope this mutually beneficial relationship will continue for many years and the shared information across the globe will continue to help many children with disabilities.



## Meet the 2014 summer counselors


