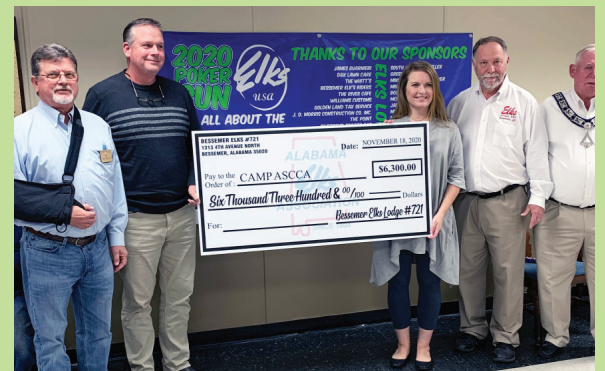


Our staff was invited to the Bessemer Elks Lodge as they held their first annual Poker Run for Camp ASCCA!
