

# AT HOME MEDICATION PACKAGING

All medications taken in pill form must be pre-packaged in approved blister cards.

Daily prescribed medications AS WELL AS over-the-counter medications may all be packed together. OTC medications (such as melatonin and vitamins) **DO NOT** require a prescription, all other medications DO.

Ask your pharmacy to print all prescription labels. You can simply staple or tape to blister packs, OR put the labels AS WELL AS packaged blister cards in a large ziplock bag.

All medications that can not be blister packed (i.e. liquids, inhalers, creams, drops) must be in the original bottles with prescription attached.

It is up to you to package blister cards EXACTLY as the prescription says!!

Please pack one extra dose of each medication!
